Anyone attending Nationals may enter Championship Basic, Two Baton, Three Baton, Miss Photogenic, Pom Girl, Halftime events, Individual Show Twirl and the Open Advanced/Elite Twirling and Strutting events without prior qualifications.

RULES and GENERAL INFORMATION

All rules and regulations for Nationals are the same as those in the current Rule Book for individual and team events. This sheet if furnished to cover some areas not covered and to clarify some which are too open for personal interpretation.

- 1. **DMA PHOTOGENIC** is open to any contestant who is entered in one event at Nationals. To be eligible, you MUST have submitted a picture for the National Program and this is the picture to be judged for photogenic. No other photographs will be considered. DMA's MOST PHOTOGENIC will be chosen from among the winners selected above.
- 2. **ADMISSON** to all events will be controlled. Contestants are admitted to all events in which they participate.

Admission is \$15.00 Adults ... \$5.00 Children (ages 6-12) ... 5 and under Free

You may buy a WEEKLY ADMISSION PASS instead of the daily fee. Cost is \$70 (Adult) ... \$20 (Children 6-12) and MUST BE PRE-ORDERED & PRE-PAID by May 27, 2023 and sent to Diane Sorvillo ... P.O. Box 549, Odessa, FL 33556 (Will_NOT be sold at the door)

4. **BEGINNER / INTERMEDIATE HALFTIME Category:** The same rules apply as written in the DMA Rule Book for Halftime events. To be eligible to enter the Beginner / Intermediate Halftime event, you must be a beginner or intermediate twirler. You may not enter two halftime events. If you are a beginner or intermediate twirler and wish to enter DMA Halftime, you may do so, but not both. Winners of Beginner / Intermediate Halftime on the National level are no longer eligible to enter this event.

DMA COLLEGIATE HALFTIME: Routine content and time limits are the same as for other halftime events.

JR. DMA HALFTIME - DMA HALFTIME: Winners of Halftime titles (Jr. DMA Halftime, DMA Halftime, Jr. High School Majorette, and High School Majorette) may not enter for the same title again. Advancement: Jr. DMA Halftime winners are eligible to enter Jr. DMA Halftime Elite and/or Jr. High School Majorette. DMA Haltime winners are eligible to enter DMA Halftime Elite and/or High School Majorette. The same progression applies to Jr. High School Majorette and High School Majorette titles. Fall Classic Halftime winners are not part of an advancement system.

5. GRAND NATIONAL TWIRL OFFS and STRUT OFFS:

Juv. Grand National - top two in 0-6 and 7-8 will twirl off and strut off.

Jr. Grand National - top two in 9-10 and 11-12 will twirl off and strut off.

Sr. Grand National - top two in 13-14 and 15-23 will twirl off and strut off.

Grand National Elite - top two in each age division will twirl off and strut off.

- 6. NON-BATON TEAMS: In the team manual where it states "everyone must perform the same routine," this should not prohibit one part of the group performing one movement while another part performs something else, or if one or two people are featured for a part of the routine. This wording was put in the manual to eliminate human props or people being put on the floor for the sake of number requirements.
- 7. **SPECIAL BEGINNER** contestants may also enter Beginner events.
- 8. Contestants may enter for Beginner and Intermediate title, and Intermediates may also enter for the advanced title, however, they may ony receive one of these titles as an award. They will be awarded the highest level title. (NOTE: This does not concern twirling or strutting - you may win awards in both levels in these events.)

An advanced contestant may NOT enter the elite category for a title or for twirling or strutting events. You must earn the right to be in the elite category.

9. No Rosin or other material may be added to the gym floor for any event !!! Violation of this rule may cause disqualification. The Main Gym will be open from 7:00 - 8:00 AM on Sunday - Wednesday for practice.

THERE WILL BE A PRACTICE GYM AVAILABLE.

- 10. Teachers and parents are not permitted to stand in the gym doorways on the lower level. These areas must be kept open.
- 11. FANCY STRUTTING The first 8 counts must be straight forward without baton releases. No leaps or any other step other than left-right-left straight down the floor for 8 counts.



- 12. **SHOW PRESENTATION ROUTINES:** Time limit is 1:30 2:30 minutes. Rule change Oct. 10, 2022: Only ONE BACKDROP piece may be on stage (8' x 10'), enhancing the presentation. This will be measured backstage. If more than the required limit a 2-point penalty will be charged. **ANY OTHER ITEM (PROPS) ON STAGE (LIMIT 2) MUST BE USED DURING THE SHOW PRESENTATION** or the contestant will be penalized as too many props (2-point penalty).
- 13. Miss Pom Girl routines will be done to standardized music provided by DMA.
- 14. ALL STAR TITLE: To be eligible you must enter All Star Solo / Elite / B/I, All Star 2 B. / Elite / B/I, and All Star 3 B. / Elite / B/I.

TEAM RULE CHANGE: A general penalty of 2 points will be assessed for a violation of rules where there is no specific penalty in the rule book. NOTE: This is NOT required as a penalty. Judges may give any portion of points they deem appropriate but not more than 2 points. (This penalty was originally 5 points.)

Time limit for all teams is 2 to 3 minutes.

NOTE: No team or individual is permitted to use the American Flag (of any size) as a show item where it is in any manner other other than in a respectful color presentation or as a part of a regular color guard unit.

Only handicapped persons will be allowed to use the HANDICAPPED SECTION, we will provide seating. It will be monitored. Failure to abide by this MAY cause disqualification. YOU MUST REQUEST A PASS BY: May 27, 2023.
